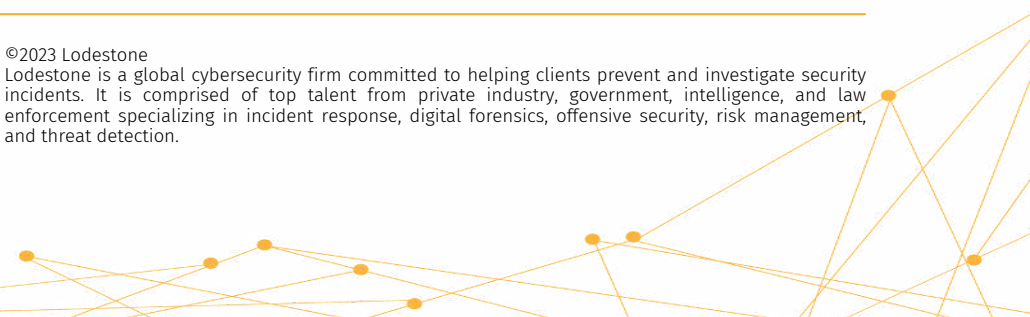
DURATION AND DELIVERABLES
